- Hands free microphone (i.e. lapel/clip-on or wraparound for the ear)
- Ability to play music on house speakers
- Power strip
- Extension cord
- Screen or blank wall
- Small table and chair on the platform
- LCD projector
- Bottled water

Room Setup

The following recommendations will add to the effectiveness of Danny's presentation as well as the overall success of his talk.

- Theater-style seating (ideally with a center aisle)
- Stage with plenty of room for Danny to walk side to side and no one seated behind him (this causes distractions for the audience)
- Front row as close as possible to the stage (ideally no more than 6-10 feet away)
- Do not overset the room. Better to have to add chairs than to have empty spots throughout the audience and an empty front row.
